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## New Early Childhood series shows little ones that everything in the world aligns with Scripture

EVANS, GA — Truth. God. Life. Humans. Morality. We must build a solid biblical foundation in these areas if we want our little ones to follow Jesus. And that is exactly what Foundation Worldview's new Early Childhood Worldview Curriculum does for children ages 4-8. The goal at the end of the five units is that children will see that everything in the world aligns with the worldview presented in Scripture.

The Early Childhood Worldview Curriculum is divided into the five units, each with five lessons. The lessons engage children and guide their thinking through body movements, songs, Bible verses, coloring activities, games, and more.

"As we go through all of these concepts, what we're doing is setting the foundation so that our kiddos first understand these truths that stem from the biblical worldview," Foundation Worldview Founder Elizabeth Urbanowicz said. "Second, we want them to be prepared to combat the lies that they will continue to face in culture."

The first unit, "Truth," explores feelings and discerning between truth and feelings. The curriculum asks the question, "Did that feeling point me to the truth or away from the truth?" The second unit, "God," explores the attributes of God in an age-appropriate manner. The third unit, "Life," dives into creation. The fourth unit, "Humans," discusses how God made humans as His image-bearers distinctly male and female. The final unit, "Morality," explores right and wrong.

In addition to this new Early Childhood Worldview Curriculum, Foundation Worldview released the Studying the Bible Curriculum for children ages 8-12 this summer.
